This webinar focuses on the annual Voluntary Protection Programs (VPP) self-evaluation, specifically how to prepare for and develop each section of the evaluation. This webinar helps you understand why an annual self-evaluation is necessary, how to retrieve the annual self-evaluation template, deciding who should be responsible for writing each section, and tips to prepare a written evaluation of each sub-element.

This webinar concludes with ideas for using the self-evaluation results to improve your safety and occupational health management system (SOHMS)
