The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) requires all facilities comply with the revised NFPA 652, Standard on the Fundamentals of Combustible Dust (2019). This webinar provides an overview of what combustible dust is, common combustible dust sources, and potential hazards. The webinar focuses on the dust hazard analysis (DHA) requirements outlined in the standard, as well as possible controls. In addition, the webinar provides information on management system expectations, such as training and communication requirements, related to the DHA.
